Temperature Adaptation of Biological Membranes

This book examines current knowledge of the physical/structural adaptations of membranes to fluctuations in temperature. New genetic and molecular biology approaches to investigating the underlying machinery are presented in the book. Also included are new perspectives on mechanisms of cold and heat damage and adaptation endowing enhanced thermoresistance. There are sixteen chapters covered in five sections. • Membrane biophysics • Biophysical studies of membrane adaptation • Biochemical studies of membrane adaptation • Genetic and molecular approaches to membrane adaptation • Functional adaptations of biological membranes.

Biochemists and biophysicists will be interested in this book as the thermal adaptations observed in membranes provide an ideal simple but clear-cut model for the regulatory control of membrane structure and function.
