**Biochemical Society Transactions.** This journal contains unedited reports of the formal presentations of data and comments communicated to the Biochemical Society at Meetings and Colloquia organized either by the Society or by the Groups of the Society. It is not a journal for the direct reporting of biochemical data. However, short reviews that survey important areas of biochemistry will be considered, but authors should consult the Managing Editor of *Biochemical Society Transactions* before preparing such articles.

Communications to be published in *Biochemical Society Transactions* should be prepared to the instructions printed in the current copy of the Agenda Papers. The general requirements for presentation will be similar to those of the *Biochemical Journal*. Should any problems arise concerning the preparation of papers for *Biochemical Society Transactions* authors are recommended to use the 'Policy of the Journal and Instructions to Authors' [*Biochem. J.* (1976) **153**, 1–21] as a general guide. SI symbols for units will be used [see *Pure Appl. Chem.* (1970) **21**, 1–44; *Quantities, Units & Symbols* (1971) The Royal Society, London].

In 1976 Volume 4 will be published. This will be in six parts published at approximately bi-monthly intervals. The subscription to non-members will be £24.00, except for subscribers in U.S.A., Canada and Mexico, for whom the rate is \$60.00 or the sterling equivalent at the time of payment. Despatch will be made by air freight to these countries.

A concessionary joint subscription is available to subscribers to both the *Biochemical Journal* and *Biochemical Society Transactions*, at a saving of £10.00 (\$25.00). The joint subscription is £138.00 (air freight joint subscription \$355.00 or the sterling equivalent).
