Short Biochemical Reviews, Book Reviews, Special Lectures of the Society and other information of biochemical interest are also included. Research papers are not accepted for publication directly.

Manuscripts reporting contributions to a Society Meeting must conform to the style of the *Biochemical Journal*. For general guidance see *Biochem. J.* (1978) **169**, 1–27. Data should be expressed in SI units [see *Pure Appl. Chem.* (1970) **21**, 1–44; *Quantities, Units and Symbols* (1971) The Royal Society, London]. Typescripts are technically sub-edited, but are not edited for scientific content, which is entirely the responsibility of the authors.
