Data should be expressed in SI units [see *Pure Appl. Chem.* (1970) **21**, 1–44; *Quantities, Units and Symbols* (1971) The Royal Society, London]. Typescripts are technically sub-edited, but are not edited for scientific content, which is entirely the responsibility of the authors.
